JAPANESE TRAIN CRASH

The Yama-Garta border, the scene of a serious train crash. This is the country of snow decked mountains and avalanches, a wild terrain where the track is exposed to the fury of storm and tempest. A heavy fall swept down the mountainside and wrecked a bridge at the bottom. As the train raced out of the tunnel the driver had no time to pull up before he reached the stricken ridge, and engine and carriages plunged into the River Alra, killing sixteen passengers and seriously injuring 28. The avalanche had done its worst.
