"BOMB MAN" INTERVIEWED.

Mr. Frederick Leighton-Morris removed a time bomb from a crowded building against police instructions, and in consequence was fined £100.

At this spot, carrying a bomb, Mr. Leighton Morris ran into a spot of bother in the shape of a policeman who said, in effect, "You can't do that there here". But he did, and, well, here's Mr. Leighton-Morris.

"Yes, its quite true that I was fined £100 but I shall not pay on principle. I shall go to prison instead. In my view, the Magistrate, at the worst should have warned me and imposed a nominal fine of a few shillings. I am making this protest in the interests of the public".
