**AERO ENGINES "BY NUMBERS"**

American Aircraft production speeds-up as hundreds of planes destined for Britain take shape in factories all over the U.S.A. Seven thousand parts - accurate to the Nth degree - must be made before a single engine can be assembled. When completed, each motor goes on a testing bench for a ten hour check by expert observers.

Thousands of pounds worth of mechanical perfection is then mounted in fighter aircraft, and the test pilots take over.
