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IN TOBRUK HARBOUR.

Soon after the Italians were driven out of Tobruk by Wavell's Army, a British warship enters the harbour. Through the mist is seen all that our warships and planes left of the Italian Cruiser SAN GIORGIO- just a pile of scrap iron.

Let's go aboard and take a look at close quarters.

The SAN GIORGIO is (or rather was) a 10 thousand ton ship with 10 inch and 7.5 inch armament. She was torpedoed early in the war and finished her career in the mouth of Tobruk Harbour - just - like - this!
