EMIR BECOMES AIR COMMODORE.

At Amman in Transjordan, the Emir Abdullah assumes the rank
of Air Commodore in the Reyal Air Perce; receives his pennant
at the hands of the Group Captain commanding the station,
and expresses his thanks through an interpreter. His Highness
inspects the parade of airmen drawn up to do him homour, and asks
many questions when taken to examine a number of planes of varying
types, grouped especially for the eccasion. To music, supplied
by the band of the Arab Legion, he takes up position for a march-past of
airmen - with fixed bayonets, a fly-past of Lysanders and a drive-past
of armoured cars.

Transjordam(just in case you have forgottem) is under the same mandate as Palestine; And the Emir (second son of King Mussein of Mejaz) is a loyal friend of the Empire.
