THE NAVY'S RAID ON LOFOTEN

In a daring and highly successful raid, British and Norwegian forces swept down on the Lofoten Islands off Narvik. In one lightning thrust we crippled industries which the Germans were using for extracting Glycerine for Munitions.

Nazi operated fish-oil factories and petrol storage-tanks were destroyed, we sank 18,000 tons of enemy merchant shipping and took 220 prisoners.
