

U.S. SEIZES AXIS SHIPS.

Wartime drama in American waters. Coastguardsmen at Norfolk speed to take Axis ships into protective custody. In a dozen harbours they're boarded without warning to prevent widespread sabotage and possible scuttling. Seventy German and Italian Vessels are seized. A tip that Rome ordered their destruction led to the U.S. Government's swift counter-move. Some 875 Huns and Wops are rounded up, when undeniable evidence of a systematic attempt to wreck all machinery is disclosed.

Forty Danish ships are also boarded, bringing the total seizure to 300,000 tons.

Among the captive crews sent to Ellis Island for Internment, the least worried are the Danes. No, not even annoyed -least of all the little lass from Denmark. And equally happy is the ship's mascot, who rather enjoys Uncle Sam making a Monkey of the Axis.
