

MR, CHURCHILL VISITS CZECH ARMY IN BRITAIN.

Czechoslovakian troops stationed in this country wearing British battle dress and full equipment, parade for an inspection by the Prime Minister and their Premier Dr. Benes. Accompanying them are Mr. Harriman (President Roosevelt's special envoy) and Major-General Arnold, Chief of the American Army Air Corps.
