NOTES

The German battleship Bismarck was sunk at 11.00 a.m. on Tuesday May 27th. 1941; she was sunk about 400 miles west of Brest after a naval chase of 1,750 miles. The battleship was torpedoed by aircraft and destroyers which reduced her speed, British ships then engaged her with gunfire, and then the cruiser H.M.S. Dorsetshire closed in and sunk the Bismarck with torpedoes.

H.M. Cruiser Dorsetshire was lost by a Japanese air attack in the Indian Ocean in April 1942.

H.M.S. Rodney was scrapped at the end of the war - battleship.

H.M. Cruiser Sheffield is one of the five Southampton class cruisers she survived the war and was still in service in 1948.

H.M. Battleship Prince of Wales was lost off Malaya on Wednesday December 10th. 1942.

H.M. Aircraft Carrier Ark Royal was lost off Gibraltar ~~from~~ after being torpedoed by an enemy submarine on Friday November 14th. 1941.
