Here are further pictures of the Allied Drive through Syria.

Night and Day artillery duels preceded the victorious advance on Damascus... the capital city. It was shortly after our cameraman recorded these scenes that General Dentz, the French High Commissioner in Syria made formal application to the British for an armistice.

Empire and Free French Troops including Colonial units from the Cameroons, press onward along the road leading into the Mother City of the World.

During its existence of over 4000 years, Damascus has been ruled by Syrians, Persians, Greeks, Romans, Turks and the French. Towards the ancient city rumbles an army, to liberate it from Nazi influence.

The fall of Damascus marks a conclusive phase of the Syrian Campaign. Free French Cyrassian cavalry leads the way, into the now freed city rejoicing in the end of hostilities.

General Legentilhomme who was injured in the fighting, arrives with General Catroux at Government House to accept the formal surrender of the City.
