Euston Station becomes the terminus of a dramatic story far more thrilling than any fiction, when Free French Officers in London meet French soldiers just landed in this country after fourteen months of incredible adventure.

One hundred and eighty three officers and men captured by the Germans during the battle of France who escaped into Russia from German prison camps, arrive in London to serve with the Free French forces. Led by an Officer with a splendid fighting record, the men, toughened by hardship, recounted stories of suffering, privation and infinite daring.

Many of them carry wounds suffered from German snipers who chased them, or from attacks by dogs sent after them by their Nazi guards. All are filled with a burning hatred of the Germans. Their one ambition now is to avenge last year's defeat of France. An ambition shared by every one of us.
