These further pictures taken by our cameraman in Iceland show the arrival of more American troops at the harbour of Reykjavik. In his own words, The disembarkation was carried out without a hitch despite rain and a biting wind which made the task far from pleasant. Comfortable quarters prepared by an advance guard are awaiting them however, and lorry loads of damp doughboys head for them.

The domestic side of life in Iceland is greatly assisted by the natural hot springs on the Island. A constant supply of hot water is a washerwoman's dream come true. This is something like - every comfort: Hot and Cold: modern: outdoor san: etcetera.

Conveyed by pipes, the naturally heated water serves the hothouses in which are grown a wonderful variety of flowers, fruits, and vegetables. Cripes, Grapes!
