MOPPING UP IN LIBYA.

Grossing the desert South of Tobruk, British armoured cars
form part of a giant circle which, while receiving wireless
directions from one of our Generals at the front, weave an iron
web in which to trap the remaining pockets of enemy resistance around
Sellum and Bardia. The route from El Gobi to El Adem is but
one of Rommel's military grave yards. A desert cemetary in which are
being hunted-out the stragglers of a now shattered Axis force.
Sections of infantry are seen here mopping up the tattered remains
of Remmel's "left-overs", abandoned with their dead in the Nazi
General's head-long flight to Benghazi and beyond.

In Cyrenaica, British and Imperial forces have won a magnificent victory.
