

INTRODUCING THE BOSTON III.

Another new R.A.F. headache for the Germans; Boston 3 Medium Bombers of the type used with striking success in daylight raids on France and Germany. Their bomb-load is about twice that of the Blenheims and they travel at greater speed. These swift and powerful aircraft are keeping up the reputation they have already won in the Middle East. Two powerful Wright Cyclone motors, of sixteen hundred horse-power each, give the Bostons splendid performance.
