BURMA... LATEST PICTURES

During recent months, General Chiang Kai-Shek has been making entensive journeys to India and war zones in the Far East. At a Burnese Airport we see the Chinese Generalissime arriving for consultations with British Military Leaders, accompanied by his devoted wife and constant companion. Ever at his side, Madame Chiang (whose Christian name is Mei-Ling) acts as his interpreter. The President and his wife have worked miracles for Medern China.

Of the war in Burma, These pictures show Burmese and Indian troops under cover of entreached riflemen, making an approach to the town of SHWEGYIN to recapture it after Japanese occupation. To cross the Sittang River, these men, who are fighting so gallantly alongside British troops, embark on Sam-pans and bamboo rafts, to be ferried over to the township in which is lurking the rearguard of the evacuating Japanese. Once over the wire barricade an enemy sniper brings down one of the attackers; but the remainder press on and enter the house which was previously Japanese headquarters. Fifth Columnists are continually being rounded up. They are reported to be extremely active in Burma. But Ghurka patrols soon have SHWEGYIN under their control.
