The famous herring run at Middlebersugh, Massachusettes is now in full spate and millions of gambelling fish transform the river into a symmkling jewel, and to the fishermen it is a jewel. It is their busiest and mest prefitable season. Here you see them undering the fish into the note. The note are hauled in with their silvery harvest and soon at market the silver will be turned into gold. From streams to barrels and trunks. Each time the not is laid it means a hundred barrels of fish, and the catch yields on an average a thousand barrels a day. The town gets a rental for the use of the river and the men can fish in it four days a week from summine to sumset. These fish were bern in the river three years ago and they always come back to the same place to spann. The fish run will last until about the ist. of June, meanwhile this haul is on its way to be canned.
