The hideeus sight of a fire-swept Burmese town by night 
The awful result of a Japanese attack on a completely undefended town, from which the population fled as the place is gutted by wholesale fire. The sole inhabitant is the cameraman, moving from one blazing building to another in this modern Dante's Inferne.

The flimsily built homes of the pourer section and the more stoutly constructed buildings in the Bazaar, were equally fuel to the incendiary bombs rained down by the Japanese raiders.

From scenes such as these the panic stricken people of many towns in Burma have fled in their thousands, moving in great Colonies from the terror which sweeps across their land.
