Inferno.

The flimsily built homes of the poorer section and the more stoutly
constructed buildings in the Bazaar, were equally fuel to the
incendiary bombs rained down by the Japanese raiders.

From scenes such as these the panic stricken people of many towns
in Burma have fled in their thousands, moving in great Colonies from
the terror which sweeps across their land.
