

TRIAL OF NAZI SABOTEURS.

The eight German spies who landed secretly in America from U.Boats are brought to trial at Washington before a Military Court. The actual proceedings are secret, and these are the only pictures allowed to be taken.

In accordance with Military custom the court appointed counsel for the saboteurs - military officers as defence advocates. So these men will get a fair trial.

The Attorney General has a photograph identified by one of the G-men who rounded up the spies and here, with a last glance at the prisoners, I'm afraid we must leave them as further pictures or detailed reporting of the trial are not allowed.
