CHINESE ARMY IN INDIA.

With American officers in command, a newly equipped Chinese Expeditionary Force is passed through a specialised training course somewhere in India, in preparation for new action against the Japanese.

Lieutenant-General Stilwell and General Sun are the leaders of this Sino-American field Army. Stilwell put up a brave but losing fight in Burma and then led his troops to safety through 140 miles of virgin jungle. A thorough knowledge of the Chinese language enables him to push forward the schooling of this Indian based army. Equipped with American weapons, the men of Stilwell's Command constitute an extremely useful force for General Wavell's projected offensive against the Japanese in Burma.
