Bomber Command aerodrome in the Home Counties are visited by the King, during his two-day tour of the big bomber stations. His Majesty comes in contact with men who participated in the Genoa raids. In this group, he is seen with Wing Commander Slee and his crew who led the daylight raid by 94 Lancasters on the Le Creuset Works.
