- Beveridge says: "The Security Plan in my Report has 3.V. three sides to it. The Report proposes first an all in scheme of social insurance providing for all citizens and their families, all the cash benefits needed for security, in return for a single weekly contribution through one insurance stamp."
- C.U. "The benefits are to be adequate in amount and to last as long as the meed lasts. The Report proposes second a scheme of children's allowances to be paid both when the responsible parent is earning and when he is not earning. The Report proposes third an all-in scheme of medical treatment of all kinds for all citizens."
- "The National minimum is a peculiarly British idea. S.V. It means that no-one is to fall below a certain standard. It leaves everyons free to spend his income above that standard as he will."
- C.U. "It preserves the maximum of individual freedom and responsibility that is consistent with the abolition of want. This is the aim of my Report as shortly as I can put it."
- S.V. "I hope that when you have been able to study the Report in detail, you will like, it, that it will get adopted, and that so we shall take the first steps to realising that security with freedom and responsibility. That is what we all desire. *
