WAVER PIPER - WRATTARE

Did this happen to you last winter? Whether it did or not avoid fromen pipes this winter. Fuel is short and must be economized so take double care with frost pressutions. Drafts are the chief danger. Drafts through unfelted roofs, from that window, close it. From under the door, a mat or rug will stop that. From a creek, plug it up. And another tip, cover the water tank withboard, but ask your Warden first. Lag your pipes with any sacking available. If the stop-eeek is under the sink, turn it off at night and empty the pipes, but if it's outside don't touch it. Fire fighters may need water. Leaving taps running or dripping dows not help. It wastes fuel and water and the waste pipe will only freese. Take frost pressutions now, don't wait for the cold weather.
