THE KING WITH THE DAM MAIDERS.

Wing Commander Gibson V.C. who led the great Lancaster Raid on the Ruhr Dams, escerts the King during a visit by Their Najesties to an air station in the North of England. Wing Commander Gibson's brilliant achievement was accomplished with the support of a gallant band of brother airmen. They too receive the congratulations of the King. The breaching of the dams was superbly executed and resulted in enormous damage and dispocation to Germany's war industry.

Describing the raid, Wing Commander Gibsen illustrates with the belp of pictures how the attack was carried out. Descending to within a few feet of the reservoir and taking the full brunt of the defences, Wing Commander Gibson achieved one of the most devastating attacks of the war.

The floods created a serious situation in the Ruhr Valley. Finally, we interview the wife of Wing Commander Gibson at her home in Lendon, "You must feel werried about your husband semetimes Mrs. Gibson".

"I'm werried all the time". Would you like to tell us why?

Well I don't know. When they go out on these raids you never know whether they're going to return or not. You must be very proud of your husband. So proud I can hardly tell you.

Well, if my husband's efforts and all the beys in the services with him can bring this war to an end quickly, so much the better and then we can enjoy ourselves".
