PANTELLARIA ATTACKED.

Bostons and Mitchells of the North African strategic Air Perce engaged in the bembing of Pantellaria. Porty-Pive square miles of land in the Mediterranean bembed from the air and shelled from the sea. Under concentrated attack, the much beasted Italian fortress formed a frail link in the Axis chain of island bases. Air fields on Musse's Malta are peck marked with bemb craters and Italian defences are in poer shape. Completely cut off by sea, Pantellaria crumbles under the weight of attack.

Its fate become measured in step press messages which teld of its rapid decline. Substance on the island goes up in smoke, as the shadow of invasion puts Italy in a state of nervous tension.
