TITLE.:- NEW INDIAN CHIEFS.

Picturs.:- The ceremony opens with the breaking of the Union Jack in honour of the distinguished visitors --

(KAUF-NA-WAUGA)

who are led forward and introduced to Chief Red Eagle of the Caughnawaga.

(EAR-C-KWA)

Then Indians of the Iroquois tribe examine the candidates, presumably to see that they are fit and proper persons to be made Indians ! They are passed as O.K. and having been relieved of their headgear the ceremony starts.

The kneeling "white men" are first invested with handsome brocaded shawls which are laid about their shoulders --

--and then the plumed war-bonnets are placed on their heads. The new chiefs are then bidden to rise and take part in ---

---the ceremonial dance. I don't suppose Major General McNaughton C.M.G. D.S.O. or Mr. Duggan either, has ever performed a stranger dance than this !

They then smoke the "Pipe of Peace". Major General Mc.Naughton is now Indian Chief Roniekoraneron. It means "Wonderful Mind" so it's much better than it sounds.
