-- and here's the defender seen from the same angle.

You never saw this before, unless you're a flyer. It's Enterprise, leading --

-- Shemrook by nine and a half minutes at this stage of the race.

The challenger rounds the buoy on the last leg. Here she's gaining on Enterprise --
