Few obstacles are too formidable for the tank.

Do you see that wall? -or rather - did you see that wall? Our friend the tank wanted to come that way, so, come that way he did, that's all!

Next comes a demonstration of rapid transport of troops across a river.

A whole platoon tumbles into the boat and in almost less time than it takes to tell, they are well on their way across the water. No time is lost when they want to move men quickly from one point to another, nowadays.

In a very few minutes these troops are ready for action on terra firma once more.

Then, of course, guns and material have to be taken across the river.

They don't wait to build bridges for it all. This special pontoon can handle quite heavy stuff. As soon as the shore is touched the run-ways are dropped, and the pontoon is discharged without delay. A smart bit of work.

The visitors are then treated to a demonstration of the remarkable mobility of the big tank --

--which is here seen entrusting its 10 ton bulk to a floating bridge which seems to heave a sigh of relief after the tank has passed over.
