At Westminster, the gorgeous cavalcade, as it swings from Whitehall into Parliament Square, presents a spectacle of unexcelled brilliance to the assembled multitude. The State Coach is over 150 years old, and weighs four-and-a-half tons. Some of its original gilt work still remains, although it was regilded once -- for the coronation of King Edward the Seventh.

Now the procession approaches the House of Lords --to the Royal Salute by the Guard of Honour drawn up in Old Palace Yard.

The coach is drawn by eight specially trained beautiful bay horses, and one can't help being glad that these splendid animals have not been superceded by petrol.

Their Majesties enter the House by way of Victoria Tower, to open what might well prove to be a momentous session.
