TITLE.:- FRANCE HONOURS.

Picture.:- A very imposing spectacle is seen when France pays homage to her war heroes. The procession is in honour of Marshal Manoury, two Admirals and thirteen Generals.

They are represented by a symbolical catafalque upon a gun-carriage.

The President Monsieur Doumergue is seen with Monsieur Doumer watching the march past. Many other --

--notable officials pay their tribute to the departed commanders.

The guarded colours, draped with black crepe precede each regiment as they pass the symbolical coffin, which stands in front of the main gate to the "Invalides", where the mortal remains have already been laid to rest under the great dome, close to Napoleon's tomb.

Other countries were present in the homage to these French --

--heroes. No greater honour could be conferred by the Republic to any body of men than has been upon these War Chiefs buried in the National heroes tomb.
