--(as this sketch shows you), the wreck left her resting place on the bottom of the Mersey. XXXX Here's how she was slung between "Camels" for the journey to Tranmere, for beaching.

The powerful tugs then towed the still submerged wreck up the river - a slow business.

But it is better to be slow and sure in a case like this. XXXX When she has been --

--beached they will wait for a low tide, and then give her a thorough examination.
