marble into--

--position without damaging the ancient stone work  
on its way up.

The old windlass and crane used to hoist the  
statue dates from the year sixteen--

--hundred. The figure is of Saint John d'Evdes of  
Normandy,--

--the famous apostle of mediieval christianity.
