Now watch the shot which is just --

- -- coming in slow motion. Its uncanny : Von-Granm --
- is worried. Vines lures him to the left, then sends the ball to the extreme right, which just twists round the post.

This victory means that America meets France in --- the Challenge Round for the Cup.
