Picture.:- These pylons don't look very great from this distance,--

--but they are nearly five times as high as say Bush House. In fact they--

--gain for Britain the distinction of possessing the highest pylons in the world.

The structure on the right is an Anchor Tower.

As almost 50 tons of electric cable are suspended--

--between these elongated webs of steel anchorage is necessary. Even at--

--high tide, the cables will have a clearance of--

--250 feet above the Thames water-way--

--at Dagenham. This colossal engineering feat is part--

--of a new scheme to supply the country with cheaper electric current. Up to this stage the work--

--has taken six years. We are unfortunately unable--

--to state exactly when your light charges will be less heavy.
