

ALL-IN WRESTLING - -

Exciting bout, in the

"smash-and-grab" style, between Atholl Oakeley and
Armadee Blomme at the Ring, Blackfriars.

Picture.:- An eliminating fight for the Heavy-weight 'all-in' Wrestling Championship of Europe. On the left of Referee is Armadee Blomme of Belgium, and on the right Atholl Oakeley, the grand-son of Sir Charles Oakeley, a famous--

--old-time fighting baronet. Oakeley threw up fifteen hundred a year to do this.

The Belgian opens with a dive at Oakeley's legs, and brings him down heavily. The Englishman kicks like a chorus girl to get free, but can't break the Belgian's grip, and Blomme wins the first bout in six seconds.

Bout 2, and Blomme dives again. Oakeley goes down but rolls--

--over to a better hold, and gets his--

--opponent in a body scissor lock. The referee gets outside the ropes ! He can see better, or it's safer. Probably both !

And the Britisher gets the fall !

The referee is crawling about getting housemaid's knee watching the mat. Oakeley has an arm-lock !

Blomme tries to throw 14-stone Oakeley out of the ring - + fails - - gets him to the mat - - but not shoulders down - - Oakeley isn't beaten yet.

This looks like the end. Oakeley has a leg pull on Blomme that is no joke.

Oakeley is appealing for a decision, and gets it ! The ref untangles the arms and legs of the gladiators, and declares Atholl Oakeley the victor. This now puts him in the finals for the European championship. Well I hope--

--he wins it - - if he really wants it !
