--oil. Insurance officials and others interested gather
to--

--see the demonstration of this wonderful method. Fifty
gallons of oil--

--are lying in these tanks. As soon as they are touched
with a torch, they become a blazing furnace of flame.
Hitherto, the efforts of fire fighters were only in the
direction of isolating damage. Burning--

--oil was considered to be--

--beyond salvage. This discovery has changed all that.
Water is forcibly sprayed on the surface of the blazing--

--oil. This immediately turns into steam, and deposits a--

--coating of water globules over the affected area,
instantaneously suffocating the flames. Forty gallons
of water puts--

--out 50 gallons of blazing oil. A remarkable British
