has--

--a motor-cycle engine of only six horse-power. After  
having banned it, the Director of Civil Aviation, and  
the Chief of Air Staff, are--

--among interested observers of this wonderful demonstration.  
The plane can rise,--

--cruise, and land at very low speeds. Danger from low  
flying is therefore practically eliminated. Crashing  
at sixty miles an hour usually means death. At six  
miles per hour, a shaking is about the limit of damage.

A week's instruction is enough to become proficient  
in navigating this simple aircraft, and the safe backguard  
and landing is easily displayed. Adventurous motor-  
cyclists will soon scrap--

--their bikes, take up flying, and drop in on their  
friends by surprise.
