

ALL-IN WRESTLING CHAMPIONSHIP - Giants  
of the "smash and grab" style struggle  
strenuously for an hour at the Ring,  
for European title.

Picture:- Atholl Oakley, the giant nearest the camera, meets  
Henrich Freehner of Germany, for the Heavyweight Wrestling  
Championship --

-- of Europe, all-in style. By the time they've finished,  
they'll probably be --

-- all out. Anyway, crowds attend the Ring Blackfriars --

-- to see what is to happen. The wrestling time is six  
ten-minute rounds. Oakley weighs fourteen and a half stone,  
but the German is sixteen and a half. Freehner takes the  
offensive and escaping a lock, tosses Oakley over the ropes.

The man who can toss fourteen stone about like that is a  
man to be side-stepped. The Englishman gets a head-scissor  
lock on Freehner, which takes a lot of wriggling out of.  
He breaks it with a bridge --

-- just in time. The German retaliates by locking Oakley's  
head between his legs. A little more of this lifting and  
dropping and he'll give him a housemaid's knee. That round  
goes to the German.

Interest is rising ! The battle is --

-- very even up to the moment, the odds perhaps going to the  
foreigner, who is sapping his opponents strength with a series  
of difficult scissor holds, but there's --

-- very little in it. Freehner tries rapid punching to get  
an advantage but nothing happens.

The bout finishes in a draw. So they've to go all through  
that again! Well ! Well ! Well !
