The Duke of York goes on board to welcome--  
-- H.M. King Feisal of-Irak, who has--  
--left his kingdom of Irak to pay this state visit to Great  
Britain. On reaching the quay, a civic and military reception  
is accorded to His Majesty. PAUSE.

Before leaving Dover, the royal visitor inspects the naval  
guard of honour.

On his arrival in London, the Irak monarch receives a  
further welcome and --

--attended by a sovrein escort of life guards, drives with  
H.M. King George towards Buskingham Palace. This is the first  
state visit of King Feisal to Great Britain since he became ruler--  
--of his now mandate free country. At Constitution Hill, guards  
line the whole route of the royal progress. This visiting King  
took a leading part in forming the Arab Army, which later became  
Field Marshal Allenby's right wing in Palestine. It Assisted in  
the Turkish *route* and eventually *accomplished* Palestine and Syria.

For two days of his stay in Britain he will be King --  
-- George's guest at Buskingham Palace and will attend the State  
banquet there. He will --  
-- also attend the luncheon at the Guild Hall and the Tennis  
Finals at Wimbledon. These are by no means all of the many  
engagements which will be --  
-- fulfilled before he returns to his romantic kingdom in the  
glamorous east !
