In places difficult to get at, like a ship's hold--a revolving branch is dropped. A very useful invention.

Powerful pressure engines have now enabled the Brigade to throw an effective jet of water two hundred feet.

Fight jets play simultaneously from this up-to-the-minute--fire fighting float. Three thousand gallons a minute are being--hurled out of those eight nozzles. PAUSE.

The end of the show! A fine service of which we -- that is, the ratepayers -- should be proud!
