Picture: - The French political pot at last boils over. As a dead man Stavisky, the fradulent financier has done even moreharm than he did when alive. The riots which broke out in Paris have resulted in incendiarism, pillage, bloodshed, many killed, thousands injured arrests by the hundred. At times the Place de la Concorde resembled a battlefield. At the most violent moments even machine-gun firé failed to disperse the rioters. After an all-night siege of the Chamber of Deputies when sheet street barricades reminiscent of the revolution of the seventten-nineties were used by the infuriated attackers.
