A memorial to an acknowledged spy. - - The word 'acknowledged' carefully chosen.

It is at Lubeck, and perpetuates the--

--memory of CARL LODY, a German naval lieutenant, who faced a firing squad--

--in the Tower of London on November 6th, 1914. The memorial--

--shows a mediaeval knight in armour, with a hole in his breast-plate suggesting the manner of his death. LODY died the death of a--

--brave man. He faced his executioners without flinching.
