(1). Picture.:- Salzburg, the Austrian 'City of Song' receives--
--a visit from Herr Schusehnigg, the new Austrian Chancellor,--
--who succeeded the murdered Dollfuss. The Chancellor--
--is welcomed by diplomatic and civic officials and escorted--
--to the Station. Outside he inspects--
--a guard of honour drawn up--
--in the snow-covered streets and proceeds to the City Hall,
where--
--he addresses a--
--meeting of citizens, who affirm their loyalty to the regime.
The grave, unsmiling,--
--chancellor Schusehnigg is expected to visit England shortly.

(2). Picture.:- Dog racing has reached St.--
--Moriyz. In this race the principle--
--runners are Borzois, but greyhounds and--
--whippets also compete. The hare is attached--
--to a line--
