The English team turned out to meet the Welshmen--  
--in the first Rugby League International ever played in--  
--Liverpool. Wales won the toss,--  
--and got the advantage of an all too strong wind, almost a--  
--gale, in fact. A fine dash to the corner by Hudson, prepared  
by Belshaw, secured for England the first try,--  
--which Belshaw failed to convert, owing to the tremendous--  
--wind. Hudson is a very good wing three-quarters, and makes an--  
--excellent impression. Brogden, for England, got a touchdown,  
making--  
--the second try, which Belshaw does convert with a well judged--  
--kick. The Welsh tackling is spirited and usually effective,  
but the team is light--  
--and the team work not so good as England's.

--ll. Even injuries to Hudson and Smith did not destroy  
England's superiority.
