INAUGURATION CEREMONY.

Five years ago a gang of workmen started to stick their picks into this Welsh mountain side. At long last the tunnel was cut, and the viaduct above it came into being. And now the Herculean job is almost complete. Complete enough to be opened by Mr. Hore Belisha anyway. The Minister of Transport has journeyed from London to cut the tape at the mountain entrance to the tunnel; thus opening the road to the public for all time. The road is between Llanfarfechan and Penmaenmawr,

Only three-thousand feet long, it has cost two-hundred-thousand pounds. Sixty-six pounds per foot, and is claimed to be one of our greatest feats of engineering.
