DEDICATION GEREMONY.

Ancient Selby Abbey Church now has
statues of His Majesty King George and Her Majesty
the Queen, occupying two niches which have been
vacant for over eight centuries. They are part
of the Church restoration scheme which has
taken two years to complete, and has cost eleven-thousand
pounds. The re-dedication ceremony is performed by
the Archbishop of York
before a gathering of three-thousand
people. The original Abbey was founded in 1069
by William the
Conquerer, but the Church was not
mempleted for more than

two-hundred years after that date. However, it is now restored, and

stands as a great monument of ecclesiastic art and religious history.
