

FRANCE'S GREATEST AIR-WOMAN.

MEMORY HONOURED AT BIRTHPLACE.

A year ago Helen
Boucher, famous French air
woman crashed when taking up a trial machine.

The plane was smashed to atoms,
and Helen Boucher, its pilot,
was killed. This Monument has been
erected to her memory in
the village of her birth,
near Maintenon. The memorial is inaugurated
by General Denain, the French Minister for Air. From
the air, over the tiny
cemetery, aeroplanes drop wreaths of flowers. Helen
was only 26
years old when she met her death,
and her bereaved father and mother
still live to see
and receive this tribute
of the pioneering courage and
fearlessness of their dead daughter.
