this bridge, but nothing can go under it,
except the water. Wash-tubs are proving useful,
as ferries from house to house. A rather
rough journey at times. From the Saone
we go to the Rhome. (RFFECTS)

At Lyons - the Rhone ! France's great national road has become part

of the river. The bridge

of Saint-Esprit is becoming under-mined.

A barge strikes a rock in the shape
of a broken lamp standard, and is lost
until the water subsides. In the beautiful vale of Avignen
water laps

at the foot of ancient fortress castles where cattle usually grase. In fact

the district is in the deuce of a mess.

The brightest spot being the sum - - when it happens to shine !
