lately. The exit of Monsieur Herriot and his supporters caused yet another first-class

crisis, which, in its development brought down

Monsieur Laval's cabinet, forcing him to resign because of insufficient backing in the

Chamber. The event produces great excitement in the Quai

d'Orsay, and reporters work overtime, although

that's nothing very new. President Lebrun asked Monsieur Laval to re-construct. He refused. Bouisson, Herriot and Delbos also declined, but

Monsieur Albert Sarraut agreed to make an attempt.

After many critical hours, Sarraut

succeeded, and informed the President.

Notable figures are Monsieur

Delbos, replacing Monsieur

Berard as Minister of Justice.

Monsieur Flandin as Minister of Foreign Affairs,

replaces Monsieur Laval.

The Minister of War,

General Maurin, succeeds

Monsieur Fabry.

As Minister for Air

Monsieur Deat replaces

General Denain. A surprise decision.

Our Post-Master General

equivalent - Monsieur Mandel, stays the course.
