The first winter night manoeuvres of the Royal Air Force ended in tragedy. One bomber

plunged into the sea off The Hague. Three of the crew were drowned. The fourth member managed to

swim ashore. The second bomber, whose wreckage these pictures show, crashed near Petersfield, Hampshire, and

burst into flames. Three men were lost. Pilot-Sergeant Deacon was hurled out of his seat, badly injured,

but alive. He is now in hospital. 'UNIVERSAL TALKING NEWS' records these accidents with the greatest regret
